Jesus healed a man called Bartimaeus.

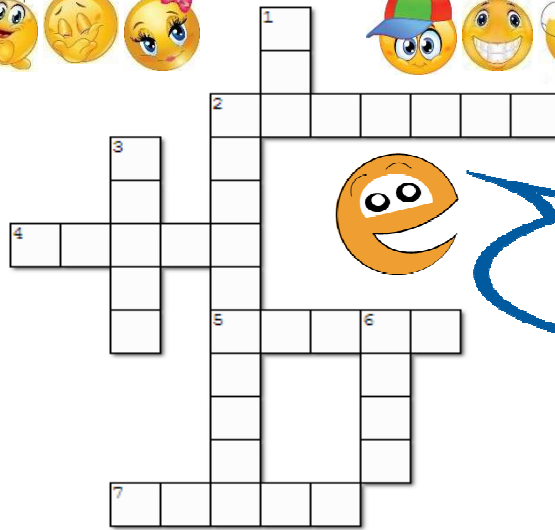
You can find the passage in **Mark 10 v 46-52**.

After a time of doing many wonderful miracles and teaching in Jerusalem and Jericho, Jesus and His disciples left. There was a lot of people who came with them because they wanted to follow Jesus to see His miracles and hear His teaching. As Jesus and the people were travelling, they came across a blind man sitting at the side of the road. His name was Bartimaeus and he was the son of Timaeus. He was begging for money or food.

When Bartimaeus heard that Jesus of Nazareth was with the people, he began to cry out and said 'Jesus, thou Son of David, have mercy on me.' Many of the people told Bartimaeus to be quiet and not disturb Jesus but he cried even louder. Jesus heard him and told the people to bring Bartimaeus to Him. They ran to Bartimaeus and tried to calm him, saying 'Be of good comfort and get up; He is calling you.' Bartimaeus threw off his coat, got up and went to Jesus who asked Bartimaeus, 'What is it that you want me to do to you?' Bartimaeus told Him, 'Lord, I would like to be able to see.' Jesus said to Bartimaeus, 'Go on your way, your faith has made you whole.' Straightaway Bartimaeus was able to see. He was overjoyed and followed Jesus and the rest of the people.

Bartimaeus had great faith in Jesus; he believed without a doubt that Jesus could give Bartimaeus his sight. The Word of God teaches us that if we believe in the Lord Jesus Christ, we shall be saved. He is able to save us because of His mighty power, shown when He bore the sins of the world on the cross and defeating death when He rose again.
