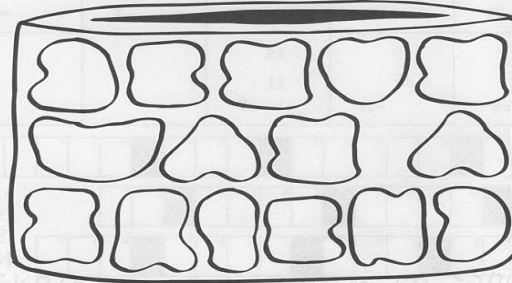

## Living Water.

Read about it in John ch 4

Jesus was travelling to a town in Samaria called Sychar. He was tired after His journey, so He sat down by the well. His disciples had gone away into the town to buy food. Soon a woman from Samaria came to the well because she needed to get some water. Jesus said to her, "Give me a drink". The woman answered him, "Why do you ask me for a drink? You are a Jew and I am a woman from Samaria. (The Jews and the people from Samaria did not get along very well)

Jesus told her that she did not know who He really was. If she had, she would have asked Him for living water, and He would give it to her, because He was God. The Samaritan woman didn't understand that the Lord Jesus was speaking about spiritual life, and she thought He was talking about the water at the well: "Sir, you have no bucket, and the well is deep. Where can you get this water that would cause me to live?"

Then Jesus told her that He could give her something even better than water. When you drink water you get thirsty again, but with the 'living water', the spiritual life that the Lord Jesus gives, He says, "You will never get thirsty again".

Do you know that this world is full of people who are spiritually 'thirsty'? They keep searching and searching for something to satisfy them, but never find the only One who can really satisfy. Children are spiritually thirsty too. Do you ever wander around, wondering what is wrong with you, wanting to try new things to see if they are fun and exciting, and satisfying? This is the thirst that Jesus spoke about. Sometimes we try to quench this thirst with adventures, movies and anything that will keep us busy, but the Lord Jesus told the woman at the well that the only true satisfaction would come when she got real peace in her soul from Him.

Do you know that all the people in this world who have trusted the Lord Jesus have a peace inside that cannot be described? The Lord Jesus has given them 'living water', and spiritually they will never thirst again. Not one Christian on earth who has this peace would give it up for a second! How did they get this peace? This peace is a gift from God, for His people, those who trust in Him. He is the only One who can take away our sins, because of His great work on Calvary. When we have our sins forgiven, we can enjoy God's rest. What do we have to do? The Bible says, "Come unto me...and I will give you rest?" If we come to Him and ask Him, He will give us forgiveness for our sins, rest and spiritual peace.
